

ETHICS & VALUES STATEMENT

The Wright-Ingraham Code of Ethics Statement outlines our stance on matters of professional ethics and institutional integrity. It applies to who we employ, our donors, and other parties with whom we conduct business, and requires all those with whom we have professional relationships to adhere to generally accepted ethics guidelines involving any interactions with humans or animals. This includes employees, interns, volunteers, associates, scholars and faculty, but also organizational and institutional entities such as grantees, foundations and trusts. We believe such principles are essential to maintaining professional morality, legality and health.

We base our values on the common principles of professional ethics:

Respect for all human and non-human life and the natural world;

Integrity, honesty and justice;

Non-violence and no-harm conduct;

Competence and accountability;

Teamwork and congeniality;

Relationships free of harassment, discrimination, and conflicts of interest.
